REMOTE REPRESENTATION Guidance for Police

This document complements the Joint Interim Interview Protocol, Version 3

The protocol and this guidance applies to detainees who are 18 and over and not a Vulnerable Adult

*Custody Officer (CO) to understand protocol and presumption of remote representation in situations where detainee has consented to it. CO must justify why protocol should not be applied if remote representation not appropriate.

Based on case by case assessment of suitability as described in JIIP para 8 and Code C 12.9A

**Inspector 'change of mind' to be done in line with PACE Code C & Note 6ZA. Any change of mind or decision not to interview to be justified on the Custody Record (CR), including the outcome (RUI, Bail etc.), as should each attempt to secure attendance of solicitor.
